



The Waltham Shuttle Route B serves member companies located along and in the Winter Street West area of Waltham. Originating from the MBTA Commuter Rail station in Waltham Center, this shuttle service makes three departures to the companies in the morning and three departures from the companies in the evening. See detailed schedule inside. The schedule is coordinated to connect with selected trains on the MBTA's Fitchburg Commuter Rail line.

ABOUT THE 128 BUSINESS COUNCIL:

In 1985, three organizations — GTE Laboratories, Polaroid, and The Nelson Companies — joined together and funded a study of the Route 128 West area between Route 2 and Route 20. The study concluded that gridlock conditions would affect the Route 128 West region if strategies to reduce congestion and increase transportation options were not put in place. The 128 Business Council is a non-profit public/private partnership that was formed to help reduce traffic congestion on Route 128 West by providing alternative transportation services and information.

The Council also works with state and federal transportation agencies on behalf of member businesses.
