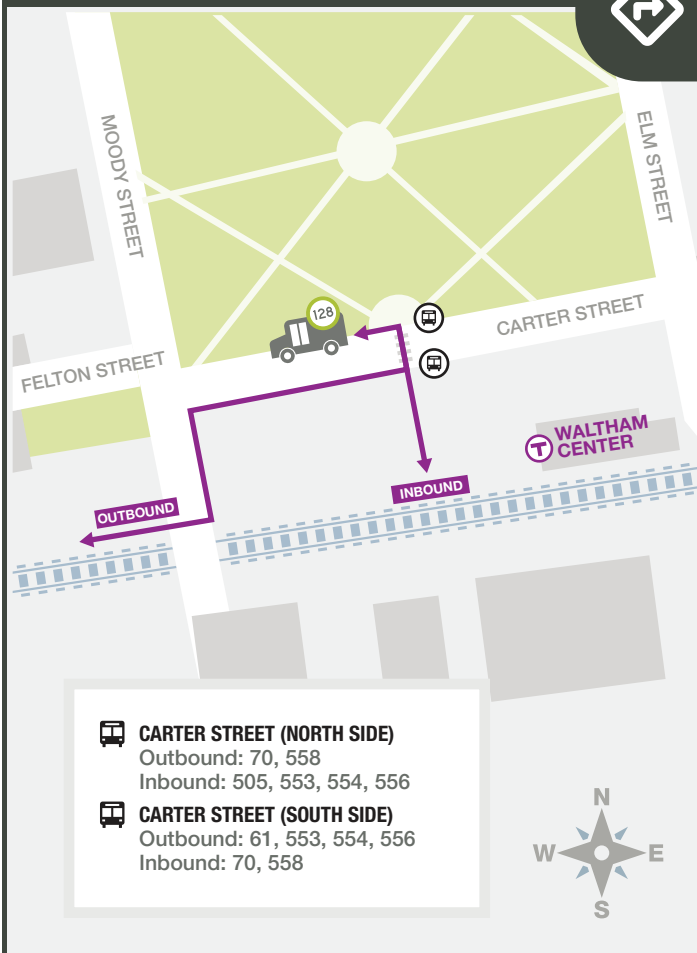

REDUCED FARES



Only riders affiliated with a 128 Business Council member company (through their employer or their employer's property owner) are eligible to ride at the reduced fare. Ask your property manager, facilities manager, or human resources department if your site is a member. Or contact us at 128bc@128bc.org.

PROCEDURES

- ✓ **Arrive at your shuttle stop 5+ minutes before the scheduled departure time.** Shuttles will not wait for late riders.
- ✓ **Inform the driver of your destination as you board.** Driver will skip unneeded stops.
- ✗ **Do not put personal belongings on seats** when those seats are needed by fellow riders.
- ✓ **Minimize conversations on the shuttle** and **use headphones** when listening to audio.
- ✗ **Do not eat on the shuttle** and **do not use foul language.**
- ✗ **Do not bring pets.** Only service animals are allowed due to space & allergy concerns.
- ✓ **Treat the driver and other passengers with courtesy and respect.**



All GRID vehicles are wheelchair-accessible.
